Subject: CHFA Sales Price Limits Update

The Connecticut Housing Finance Authority (CHFA) Bond - Sales Price Limits for the Homebuyer Mortgage Programs are being revised to comply with the Treasury (IRS) regulations regarding the use of tax-exempt bond proceeds.

> The new <u>Sales Price Limits</u> will apply to all reservations for CHFA mortgage loans <u>effective on and after January 1, 2025</u>.

There are no changes to the CHFA Bond - Income Limits at this time.
